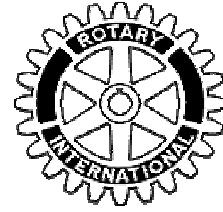

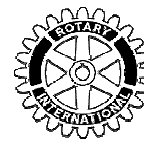

Amman, Jordan - (4 March; Amman Marriott)

Peace Dinner featuring speeches by two local dignitaries about the pursuit of peace in the region. Meet with fellow Rotarians, Senior Rotary Leaders, and local experts to explore peace-building strategies in a convivial setting.

Let it truly be said that every Rotarian is a peacemaker.

Cairo, Egypt - (5-6 March; Location: Semiramis InterContinental Hotel)

Peace Conference featuring national political and religious leaders from the First Lady of Egypt, Mrs. Suzanne Mubarak to His Excellency, Dr. Mohammed Sayed Tantawi, Sheikh of Al-Azhar and His Holiness, Pope Shenouda, the Third Pope of Alexandria, discussing the importance of interfaith education and understanding. With additional sessions on resolving conflict within your own community, aiding displaced persons, and helping Rotary achieve peace. Also included are sessions about polio eradication, Rotary's Global Quest, and Rotary extension into Islamic countries.

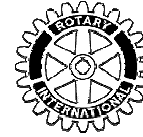
