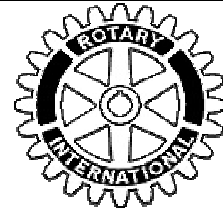

PROGRAM

Vicki Huntington was our speaker today telling us about the treaty process to date. She began her talk however, with a comment that Leslie Abramson was not even at the meeting when she had promised tom

meet Vicki at 7:15. Vicki has been involved in the treaty negotiation process for the past 6 years, and commented how difficult it is with 30 representatives at the table. There is one rep from each Municipality in the lower Mainland, and they take their job very seriously and have fought to win more influence with the province. Currently the Burrard Band in North Van and the Tsawwassen Band are the only two in negotiations, with the Tsaw. Band being much further ahead. Vicki had great praise for Kim Baird, chief of the Tsaw. Band, and noted that all information is available on the websites for Delta and the Band.

Because there is Crown land available here in Delta, it is likely that our settlement will include more land than cash. Delta Municipal staff have done a lot of work to identify all of the infrastructure amenities that are on the lands being claimed by the Tsaw. Band. Vicki feels that this process is an evolutionary one in more ways than one, and may take 100 years to finalize.
