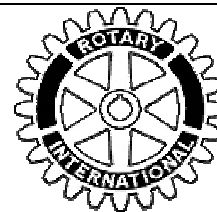

The program for the week was an assembly to update us on what is happening with our club outside of our weekly meetings. Director David Kalinovich reported that the ACC has now reached 102 packages and brought in just under \$24K. Greg Hoover reported on Community Projects - stating that many small projects had been evaluated and the following monies have been allocated: Bookmarks for Asset Building workshop – 350; Legion Poppy Drive – 200; Scouts – 500; DYS – 510; Stroke Recovery – 900; Tsaw rangers – 500; Fire Hydrant project – 270; Canadian Lifeboat Society – 1000; Delta Community Living – 3000; SDSS Cheer Squad – 1000; Air cadets – 500; Teen Conference – 500; Delta Life Skills – 500; Tsaw First Nations – 1700; Autistic Children – 1300; Mental Health – 1300. Greg also reported that the club has purchased two tents

(covers) for use at various events. Bryan Kelly updated us on the fire hydrant decals, which are now for sale on our website.

Director Norm Brown had Eleanor give an update on the conference in Penticton. All is in order and signs have been done and the early bird draws have been done...no one from our club won (probably a good thing). Don Michiel gave a member ship update...we started the year at 67 and are now up to 73. Cindy Phillip did the social report, and let us know that there will be a Guess Who's coming dinner in May, and the president's Ball is in June. Leslie Abramson reported that she had been talking with the other three clubs about a joint "sporting" event in the summer.

Director Leslie Bainbridge mentioned that all of the Elementary Schools had been given \$200 each to assist in funding outside activities for kids who could not afford them. She also asked us to try to identify young people ages 18 – 25 who might be good candidates to attend RYLA.
