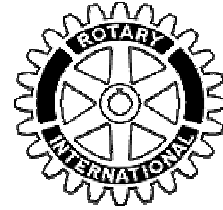

**Rotary Foundation selected as recipient of Gates Award for Global Health**

The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation on Monday [20 May] announced its selection of The Rotary Foundation of RI as the recipient of the 2002 Gates Award for Global Health. The US\$1 million award recognizes Rotary's leadership and impact in the field of public health, most notably its efforts to eradicate polio by 2005. The Gates Foundation commended Rotary for contributing more than \$462 million toward polio eradication and mobilizing more than one million Rotarians to help immunize more than two billion children against polio in 122 countries. The first Gates Award went last year to the Centre for Health and Population Research in Dhaka, Bangladesh. Based in Seattle, Washington, the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation is dedicated to improving people's lives by sharing advances in health and learning with the global community. It has an endowment of \$23 billion.
