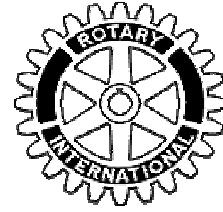

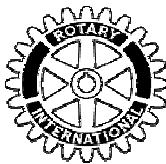

**STUFF**

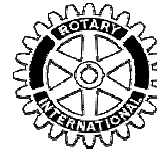
June 16 is the dedication of Diefenbaker Park. The mayor will be there.
