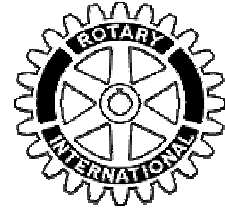

STUFF

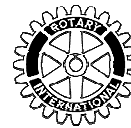
