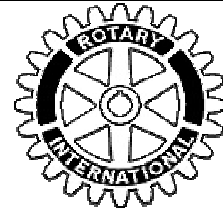

**PROGRAM**

Sharon Yardley, a local nurse who presently work in the Parkinson's research facility at UBC, was with us to tell us some of the exciting things that are happening in their labs. She let us know how well respected UBC is in the area of Parkinson's research, much of it due to the work that has been done with the Positive Emissions Thermographer (PET) scanner. Apparently patients come from all over North America to be tested on our PET scanner. This scanner allows chemicals in the brain to be monitored. Parkinson's is a loss of dopamine producing cells in the brain, and at this time the best treatment available is to replace the missing chemical by the use of medications. The PET scanner allows the doctors to better adjust the dosage of the pills.

Parkinson's is a young person's disease, thought to be caused by a one time event that destroys the dopamine producing cells. Researchers are desperately looking for the cause, as well as the cure. Our own Bruce Tuttle was pleased to share some of his experiences with this disease, and to show us how many pills he must swallow each day just to function.
