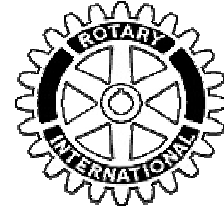

Jim Cessford, our Delta Police Chief, joined us for breakfast and the antics, and still managed to tell us about how our own police force has grown and changed over the years. Our chief is very accomplished and known across the country for his expertise. (*** I guess that's better than some of the undesirables that he deals with.... who are also well known, but for different reasons).*

Our local force is presently dealing with a series of drive by shootings in North Delta. Grow ops continue to be a problem, but after starting with about 200 last year they have whittled them down to about 30 known to the force. There are only 5 in Ladner and none in Tsawwassen, while the majority are in North Delta. Most of these grow ops are run by organised crime – often with an Asian connection. There is also a concern about other manufactured drugs. Break and Enters spiked in Feb and March, and a suspect was identified but has not been apprehended. The incidents seem to have slowed significantly since the start of the bus strike. The force is also dealing with skateboard concerns in Pebble Hill Park.

Chief Cessford thanked Randy Wolsey for all of his work to get the new Public Safety building built in North Delta. There are now 70 officers and staff housed up there, and it has made a huge difference to travelling time for local officers. The Police Force is setting up a Foundation to make fundraising easier.

Joan's Oatmeal Chocolate Chip Craisin Cookies

1 cup margarine creamed with 1 cup white a 1 cup brown sugar. Add 2 beaten eggs and ½ tsp vanilla. Stir in 1 2/3 cup flour mixed with 1 ½ tsp baking powder and ½ tsp salt. Fold in 2 cups Quick rolled oats and two cups each of chocolate chips and craisins. Drop onto cookie sheets (with silpat liners) and bake at 375 for 12 minutes till soft and chewy.
