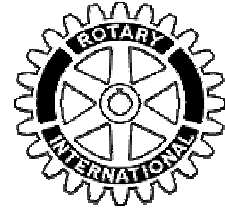

PROGRAM

Since we were in Point Roberts, Mark Lundrigan from the Point Roberts Golf Course development was our guest to tell us about the progress on the construction of the new course. There has been lots of noise and dust but only minor complaints, so he feels it must be a worthwhile project. They are almost done construction and will try to open in July next year. The course will be 6800 – 6900 yards long and for 2 – 3 years they will utilize a temporary clubhouse. Green fees will be \$65 – 70 Canadian on this public course. The course may go partly private in the future.

They have been very careful to preserve the heron rookery where 350 pairs nested this year. There is also consideration for an eagle nest in the vicinity and the clubhouse has been situated so that the nest is visible from there. Plans also include space for up to 160 residences - some multifamily, but most single-family dwellings. Cost of these homes is expected to be comparable to the Tsawwassen market.
