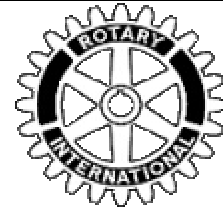

**ROTARY CORNER****Facts about the New Rotary International Credit Card Program**

With the approval of the Rotary International Board of Directors and the support of the Trustees of The Rotary Foundation, a new credit card program for Rotarians is now underway. In addition to proudly displaying the Rotary International emblem on the card itself and creating awareness of Rotary, every purchase made with the new credit card will provide a contribution to The Rotary Foundation.

The following questions and answers will be helpful to Rotarians wishing to know more about the new credit card.

**Q: Who issues the Rotary International Credit Card?**

**A:** The Rotary International MasterCard credit card is issued by MBNA America Bank, N.A., the world's largest independent credit card lender. In addition to enabling Rotarians to display their Rotary pride and help support the Foundation, the no-annual-fee card was selected because it provides a credit line up to \$100,000; a low introductory annual percentage rate for cash advance checks and balance transfers; and an optional travel rewards program.

**Q: Where can applications be obtained?**

**A:** MBNA has distributed application forms at Rotary Institutes in the United States. MBNA also sent application forms to U.S. district governors and district Foundation chairs.

Rotarians can also fill out a secure online application by going to the R.I. Web site at [www.rotary.org](http://www.rotary.org) and

clicking on the credit card icon, which links to the [MBNA site](#).
