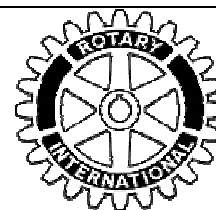

Murray Lott had a power point presentation on the skateboard park proposed for Tsawwassen. Skateboarding is the fastest growing sport, with an increase of 30% in the past two years. Many communities in BC have built parks already. The injury rate among boarders is very low, even in busy parks where kids of all ages participate. Tsawwassen's park will be built at Grauer Park; design is already underway with the kids being consulted directly, and later they will be involved in decoration. Kids tend to police themselves in most parks. The design will have stairs and curbs just like the street, and according to Murray there MUST be a bathroom. Opening is slated for June 2002.
