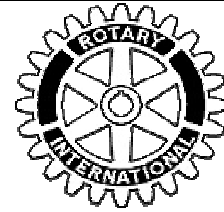

Are we really the top of the evolutionary chain?? - we're the only animal that kills it's own members. He stated that war has changed and now it happens from airplanes at 20,000 feet above the earth. He read several sonnets and poems and commented on the meanings of them.
