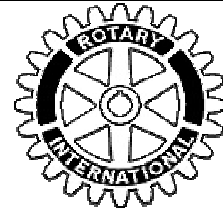

Thanks to the generous contributions of grassroots Rotarians around the world, we are on the brink of eradicating polio, a disease that has existed since the time of the ancient Egyptians. Since Rotary began its PolioPlus Program in 1985, the number of polio-endemic countries has declined from more than 125 nations to 30 at the beginning of this year. We have also recently reached another significant milestone, with the World Health organization declaring its Western pacific region as polio-free. This is the second region (the Americas was the first) to report zero polio cases for the last three years.
